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Theft Education Course Summary:

This course helps participants understand the consequences of theft, its impact on others, and the importance of accountability, honesty, and responsible decision-making. Participants will learn skills to make positive choices and avoid future offenses.

Consequences of Crime Program Summary:

This course helps participants understand the legal, personal, financial, and social consequences of criminal behavior. Participants will explore how crime impacts victims, families, communities, and future opportunities while learning accountability, decision-making, and strategies for making positive life choices.

Substance Abuse Education Course Summary:

This course provides education on the risks and consequences of alcohol and drug use. Participants will learn about the effects of substance abuse on physical and mental health, relationships, decision-making, and future goals while developing skills to make healthy, informed choices.

Anger Management Course Summary:

This course helps participants understand the causes of anger, recognize personal triggers, and develop healthy coping skills. Participants will learn effective communication, conflict resolution, emotional regulation, and stress management techniques to respond to challenging situations in a positive and productive manner.

Responsible Defensive Driving Course Summary:

This course teaches safe and responsible driving habits to help reduce the risk of accidents and traffic violations. Participants will learn defensive driving techniques, hazard recognition, traffic safety laws, distraction awareness, and strategies for making safe decisions behind the wheel.

Victim Impact Course Summary:

This course helps participants understand how criminal and irresponsible behavior affects victims, families, and communities. Through education and reflection, participants will explore the emotional, physical, and financial impacts experienced by victims while developing empathy, accountability, and a greater awareness of the consequences of their actions.

Restitution Reimbursement Placement Program Summary:

This program provides participants with an opportunity to fulfill court-ordered restitution obligations through structured community service and accountability-based activities. Participants learn responsibility, work ethic, and the importance of repairing harm caused by their actions while making positive contributions to the community.

Substance Abuse/Mental Health Assessment Summary:

This assessment helps identify potential substance use and mental health concerns that may affect an individual's well-being, behavior, and decision-making. The assessment provides recommendations for appropriate education, treatment, support services, or interventions to promote healthy functioning and positive life outcomes.

Aggressive Replacement Training Course Summary:

This course helps participants identify aggressive thoughts and behaviors and replace them with healthier responses. Participants learn emotional regulation, self-control, communication skills, and conflict resolution strategies to reduce aggression and improve decision-making in challenging situations.

Family Reunification Course Summary:

This course supports individuals and families in rebuilding trust, improving communication, and strengthening relationships after conflict, separation, or involvement in the justice system. Participants learn healthy communication skills, accountability, boundary-setting, and emotional awareness to promote healing and positive family connections.

10 Steps to Positive Change Support Group Summary:

This support group guides participants through a structured 10-step process focused on personal growth, accountability, and positive decision-making. Each step helps individuals build self-awareness, develop healthy coping skills, set goals, and replace negative behaviors with constructive choices that support long-term success.

Drug Testing Program Summary:

This program involves regular and random testing to monitor substance use and support accountability. It helps encourage sobriety, reinforce compliance with court or program requirements, and promote responsible decision-making while providing structure for maintaining a drug-free lifestyle.

Community Service Placement Program Summary:

This program places participants in structured community service opportunities to give back to the community while building responsibility and work ethic. Through supervised service, individuals gain accountability, develop positive habits, and contribute to meaningful projects that support personal growth and community improvement.
